Title: Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus

gone.

Description: A duck decides to ride a bike and soon influences all the other animals on the farm to ride

bikes too.

Title: The Farmer and the Clown

Author: Frazee, Marla (Author, Illustrator)

Description: A baby clown is separated from his family when he accidentally bounces off their circus train and lands in a lonely farmer's vast, empty field. The farmer reluctantly rescues the little clown, and

over the course of one day together, the two of them make some surprising discoveries about

themselves—and about life!

Title: The Fat Cat Sat on the Mat

Description: Rat tries to get the fat cat off the mat and back to his usual resting place in the vat.

Title: The Foot Book

Author: Seuss, Dr. (Author, Illustrator)

Description: Read about all sorts of feet doing all sorts of things.

Title: Four Seasons Make a Year

Author: Rockwell, Anne F.; Halsey, Megan (Illustrator)

Description: Describes the passing of the seasons through the changes in plants and animals that occur

on a farm.

Title: Froggy Learns to Swim

Author: London, Jonathan; Remkiewicz, Frank (Illustrator)

Description: Froggy is afraid of the water until his mother, along with his flippers, snorkle, and mask,

helps him learn to swim.

Title: From Maple Trees to Maple Syrup

Author: Keller, Kristin Thoennes

Description: An introduction to the basic concepts of food production, distribution, and consumption by

tracing the production of maple syrup from maple trees to the finished product.

Title: Gaston

Author: DiPucchio, Kelly; Robinson, Christian (Illustrator)

Description: This is the story of four puppies: Fi-Fi, Foo-Foo, Ooh-La-La, and Gaston. Gaston works the hardest at his lessons on how to be a proper pooch. He sips—never slobbers! He yips—never yaps! And he walks with grace—never races! Gaston fits right in with his poodle sisters. But a chance encounter with a bulldog family in the park—Rocky, Ricky, Bruno, and Antoinette—reveals there's been a mix-up, and so Gaston and Antoinette switch places. The new families look right...but they don't feel right. Can these puppies follow their noses—and their hearts—to find where they belong?

Description: A very picky eater, Gregory the goat refuses the usual goat diet staples of shoes and tin

cans in favor of fruits, vegetables, eggs, and orange juice.

Title: Hop On Pop

Author: Seuss, Dr. (Author, Illustrator)

Description: Pairs of rhyming words are introduced and used in simple sentences, such as "Day. Play.

We play all day. Night. Fight. We fight all night."

Title: I Want My Hat Back

Author: Klassen, Jon (Author, Illustrator)

Description: A bear almost gives up his search for his missing hat until he remembers something

important.

Title: I'm Fast!

Author: McMullan, Kate; McMullan, Jim (Illustrator)

Description: A train and a race car race each other on the way to Chicago.

Title: I'm Growing!

Author: Aliki (Author, Illustrator)

Description: Describes human growth and how the different parts of the body change as it grows.

Title: Jamaica's Find

Author: Havill, Juanita; O'Brien, Anne Sibley (Illustrator)

Description: Jamaica finds a stuffed dog at the playground and after taking him home discovers her

conscience as well.

Title: Just Saving My Money

Author: Mayer, Mercer (Author, Illustrator)

Description: When Little Critter wants a new skateboard, Dad tells him that he needs to save his own money to buy it. Little Critter tries his very best, but soon finds that saving enough for what he wants

isn't so easy.

Title: Kitten's First Full Moon

Author: Henkes, Kevin (Author, Illustrator)

Description: When Kitten mistakes the full moon for a bowl of milk, she ends up tired, wet, and hungry

trying to reach it.

Title: Leaf Man Author: Ehlert, Lois

Description: A man made of leaves blows away, traveling wherever the wind may take him.

Title: Lemons Are Not Red

Author: Seeger, Laura Vaccaro (Author, Illustrator)

Description: Explores different colors by allowing readers to change an object or animal's color from

unusual to common by turning the die-cut pages.

Title: Little Dog Lost: The True Story of a Brave Dog Named Baltic

Author: Carnesi, Monica (Author, Illustrator)

Description: A dog is rescued after days afloat on a sheet of ice in the Baltic Sea.

world, one letter at a time.

Description: Tiny and his owner are having fun camping until they discover that Tiny doesn't fit in their

tent.

Title: Too Many Fairies: A Celtic Tale

Description: An old woman complains about all the housework she has to do, but when some fairies
