### Window Displays Attract & Engage During Library Closures

While Wapiti's libraries remain closed due to COVID-19, Branch Librarians are busy creating window displays that continue to engage patrons.

In Leask, Branch Librarian Connie Peake is creating a rotating series of picture book window displays. Parents bring their children to read the stories from outside the library.

"We wanted to keep the library in people's minds during our closure," said Peake. "I noticed people putting hearts inside their windows and thought that our library could do a take on that idea."

Peake condenses the stories and makes sure the display is low enough on the window so small children can see and enjoy it.

At the Melfort Public Library, staff are creating "I Spy" displays inside one of the library windows. The displays consist of a collection of various items along with a posted list of what children should look for.

The list contains named items, but to make the game more challenging and engaging, it also contains a riddle or two that must be solved before additional pieces can be identified. To keep interest keen, the display is changed weekly.
